

Hard life of a firefighter and what do



If you look at the life of a firefighter, you can simply assume that firefighters spend their time waiting out on calls, nap, play cards, or jokes with each other. This type of working day was so long ago, but much has changed since then.

These days, **the firefighters spend their free time to update their skills in different subjects**, as well as taking on a new formation, challenges and opportunities. A **firefighter typically works 48 hours at a stretch**, followed by a long time outside of work. The following is just a snap shot of just a day of a fire fighter, just to know how hard his life is.

Beginning of the day

Firefighter comes to participate in a vote by roll **call usually at the fire station about 8.00 clocks**. During or immediately after the call the missions and tasks are usually distributed. The calendar is also given, since no calls during the day.

In the morning hours, usually inspect the fire and wait for fire-fighting vehicles to ensure that they are in optimum shape in emergency situations, a little housework care around the fire pit, to participate in physical education at least a decent level of fitness, and various other

activities to obtain. The firefighter program from day to day with several new applications.

Noon

After morning work most of the **firefighters usually take rest at noon along with having a lunch**. Lunch is usually beginning in the order of 1 or 2, and then firefighters go for the fulfillment of their assigned tasks.

For example, the large training sessions in the afternoon will be held. Firefighters deal with things such as the *formation of new techniques for firefighting*, the *improvement of existing, participating in inspections*, maintenance of equipment, and more.

Afternoon

In the afternoon and late evening, just before sunset, firefighters are usually still with all the other *tasks, write reports and take care of unfinished business*. Dinner is usually prepared at this time as well. In the late afternoon and early evening is not usually planned a period of time. **A firefighter can be expected for tests or exams to study reports the surface** or to work on projects or special assignments.

Until late at night

Fireman goes to sleep late at night, after the hectic day.

Call

The working day does not cover claims which may come at any time. Even if you receive a call, at 03:00 clock, **firefighters are required to respond immediately**, regardless of whether they were asleep or not.

In general it can take half an hour to several hours an appeal. Some calls may call for a single truck, while others need the help of some truck. Since emergency calls are unexpected and spontaneous, **the program of a typical day can be incredibly touched** or changed. Because the calls are random in their presence, firefighters must learn to work **flexibly** in order to respond as **quickly** as possible.
