

What are the Jobs at Walt Disney Park & Resorts?



Disney offers a **paid internship program for students** to Disneyland in *Anaheim, California* and Walt Disney World Resort in *Orlando, Florida* area.

Candidates can [apply online for the Disney College Program](#). The program is open to citizens and candidates **from outside the United States**.

This program runs during the school year; **Disney College Program** is not only during the summer months. Applicants must **be at least 18 years old** and **a work permit without restrictions**.

The Disney College Program is open to students. If a person in the program of training, **accepted financial support**, they should contact their school counselor to find out the impact that the training paid for the help they can get.

Disney staff leads presentations at schools in *California* and *Florida* each spring and fall. The potential trainees have the opportunity to develop a presentation to display more information about the program offers. **Interviews can be conducted immediately** after the presentation immediately by telephone or in person.

courses in personal and professional development. Interns are hired to **work during the holidays**, houses, shops, attractions and other roles.

An example of one of the courses that are offered by Disney is the training program in **Operations Management**. This is a *full-time*, paid internship training, operations management, project management and business. The intern wills the training and education.

The **program begins in January of each year**; applications will be accepted in September for the following January. To be eligible, applicants must sign a four-year College or university in the last 10 months has offered complete. A person who has taken a job at Disney does not have the right to participate in the training program.

A person who is accepted into the *college program* of work experience at Disney, adapt to their interests and learning objectives. Disney intern consults with the school to try to determine how to **earn the student college credit** for the program.

It is a good opportunity to gain practical experience in your field of study, and you have the option of the company that you are a good candidate for a full-time job at Disney land.

Disney employees help seniors share their professional experience, students gain an understanding of career paths within the company. **Computer, books and videos** are also available for students in the learning process.

Graduate internships offered. Accepted this program offers several benefits, including **discounts on food and drinks, free Disney theme parks and invitations to social events**, to occupy the access. Those who are interested can be taken into account in an online account via Walt Disney for one of these possibilities.

Due to the nature of the business Disneyland Resort candidates, they can do jobs such as **restaurant manager, automotive mechanic, Disney store assistant store, financial analyst accounting, bilingual compliance coordinator** etc...

Intern will work in a professional program for a period of 5-7 months. You need to find your own accommodation while participating in the program and must have a reliable vehicle for the job.

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
