

What not to say at a job interview

Better control over nerves may help you perform well during the interview. Fear causes slip of tongue that can cause bad interview. Nervousness is normal, and investigators expect to have nervousness. But there is a boundary between a healthy dose of fear and panic point.

The following three statements are the most common negative statements made by the interviewees.

Negative Declaration No. 1: "I'm here to interview you and I have some questions I'll ask."

Why not it is true that the interview should be a two-way street, there is such a thing as too aggressive. You can ask questions . You'll do not preach. It is not necessary, and it is bad style . Instead , just ask questions during the interview or wait until the interviewer asks if you have any questions.

Negative Declaration No. 2: "Before we go any further, what is the salary for the position, I do not want to waste your time or mine."

Reason to Avoid: Avoid this negative statement, the interviewer is on the defensive position. It will make your image bad. If you have an idea that wages should not be too low , keep calm, go through the motions of the interview, and listen to what the interviewer say. You might be surprised by the results.

Negative Declaration No. 3: "I'm not sure about this position."

Reason to Avoid: an interview is not a confessional. It must be your goal to get an offer, even if you are not sure if you want the job . Put aside your thoughts that are not very enthusiastic, and focus your energy to find information about the position and adjusting the organization.
